In 1958, Jørgen Rasmussen and his brother began working for KEVI A/S. The twins designed a villa for KEVI's CEO, Bent Harlang.

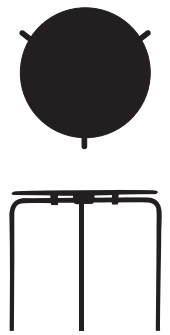
KEVI TABLE

DESCRIPTION

Round stacking table with three legs. 22 mm tube in chrome or powder coated in black. Ideal for cafes, restaurants and the small kitchen.

Tabletop in veneer in oak or walnut, or lazure in black or white.

PACKAGING

The tables are packed in strong cardboard packaging with a protective piece of cardboard between each table and protection plastic. Up to four tables in one box.

NOTE

For all tables, delivery applies to the door or ramp. consider the tabletop size in both transport and installation.
