JØRGEN RASMUSSEN
(1931)

Jørgen Rasmussen was born in Odense on April 26, 1931. He graduated from the Royal Danish Academy of Fine Arts in 1955 and in 1957 Jørgen and his twin brother, Ib, started their own studio with a focus on single-family houses.

In 1958, Jørgen Rasmussen and his brother began working for KEVI A/S. The twins designed a villa for KEVI's CEO, Bent Harlang, after which they were asked to design the chairs for the villa.

KEVI

KEVI is a classic office chair designed in 1958. In 2016, after nearly 60 years on wheels, it was time to renew the chair. The sketches for the stackable chair have been in the Jørgen Rasmussen's archives for years and in 2016, it became reality. The four-legged KEVI was born. A stackable KEVI in two models, with chrome or wooden legs.

The KEVI stool is a natural development to the KEVI series.
